Day 7 - Gibraltar, Gibraltar**14 Nov 2026, Sat | 08:00 - 19:00**

The 1988 discovery of a magnificently preserved Roman theater remains its defining revelation, while the hilltop Castillo de la Concepción commands views across the harbor that have been coveted for centuries. Calle Mayor winds between modernist facades and ancient ruins, and the tapas bars offer Spain at its most unhurried: a cruise port as authentic as the Mediterranean gets.

Valencia balances the weight of history with the confidence of a city always looking forward.
