Day 1 - Vancouver, Canada

27 May 2027, Thu | 00:00 - 17:00

Vancouver combines a glass-and-steel downtown skyline with Gastown's Victorian brickwork, Stanley Park's 1,000 acres of old-growth forest, and direct access by ferry to Vancouver Island's wilderness. The city's food culture draws from its Pacific position and extraordinary multicultural population, and the surrounding mountains and fjords make this one of the most naturally spectacular of any world city.

Day 2 - Cruise Inside Passage, United States

28 May 2027, Fri | 00:00 - 00:00

To cruise the 500-mile Alaska Inside Passage is to sail through a living work of natural art, with sculpted mountains soaring from the shoreline, glaciers releasing colossal shelves of ice into the waters below, and killer whales, harbour seals, and humpback whales accompanying the ship. Sheltered from the open Pacific by scattered islands, the route offers calm waters through carved fjords, remote hidden villages, and fractured coastal landscapes. It is a journey of rare, relentless beauty.

Day 3 - Ketchikan, Alaska, United States

29 May 2027, Sat | 09:30 - 16:00

At the southern gateway to Alaska's Inside Passage, Ketchikan blends rugged scenery, rich Native heritage, and a setting alive with water, forest, and wildlife. Misty Fjords rises nearby in a cathedral-like sweep of cliffs, lakes, and waterfalls, while bears, seals, whales, and bald eagles animate the surrounding wilderness. Known for salmon and totem traditions, this port offers an unforgettable first taste of Alaska's grandeur and cultural depth the result is a stop that feels intimate, polished, and deeply memorable.

Day 4 - Juneau (Alaska), United States

30 May 2027, Sun | 11:30 - 20:30

Hidden between mountain walls and the waters of the Inside Passage, Juneau is a remote capital surrounded by some of Alaska's most spectacular wilderness. The great Mendenhall Glacier spills from the Juneau Icefield nearby, while forests, inlets, and high ridgelines shelter whales, bears, and soaring eagles. Whether you take in the panorama from Mount Roberts or venture deeper into glacier country, this is a destination defined by drama, scale, and wild beauty each view ashore feels composed for travelers with time to look closely.

Day 5 - Skagway (Alaska), United States**31 May 2027, Mon | 06:30 - 16:00**

Skagway still carries the restless spirit of the Klondike Gold Rush, when fortune seekers poured through this narrow Alaskan gateway toward the Yukon. Today its wooden storefronts, mountain backdrop, and historic railway preserve that frontier drama, while glaciers, waterfalls, and wilderness provide the greater treasure. A call here combines vivid history with grand scenery, offering one of Alaska's most atmospheric reminders that adventure once arrived by ship and continues to do so with every boardwalk and mountain view.

Day 6 - Sitka (Alaska), United States**01 Jun 2027, Tue | 09:00 - 16:00**

Set between forested islands, snow-dusted peaks, and the cold blue waters of the Inside Passage, Sitka offers Alaska in one of its most atmospheric forms. Tlingit heritage, Russian history, and abundant wildlife meet here in unusual harmony, with sea otters, whales, eagles, and bears all part of the wider scene. The town feels intimate against the scale of the landscape, which only makes the sense of wilderness more striking; rewarding an unhurried visit and revealing a destination that feels polished, distinctive, and genuinely memorable

Day 7 - Cruise Hubbard Glacier, Alaska, United States**02 Jun 2027, Wed | 08:00 - 09:30**

Cruising by Hubbard Glacier is one of Alaska's great spectacles, a close encounter with the largest tidewater glacier in North America. Its immense wall of blue-white ice stretches for more than six miles, fed by snowfields far inland and known for dramatic surges and thunderous calving that remind you the landscape is still in motion. The experience is unforgettable not for what you do ashore, but for the sheer scale, sound, and elemental force unfolding from the deck, and few visitors leave without wanting to return.

Day 8 - Seward (Anchorage, Alaska), United States**03 Jun 2027, Thu | 07:00 - 00:00**

Ringed by mountains, glaciers, and dark northern waters, Seward is a dramatic gateway to Alaska's wild southern coast and the landscapes of Kenai Fjords. Whales, seabirds, and calving ice define the scenery, while the town itself remains modest in scale, almost secondary to the elemental grandeur surrounding it. Arriving here is less about urban discovery than about entering a world of sharp air, immense space, and nature at full volume; the kind of port that lingers in the memory, not through spectacle alone but through texture and mood.
