Day 1 - Barcelona, Spain

Mon 28 Dec 2026 | Embarkation 12:00 P.M. - 5:00 P.M. | Departure 8:00 P.M.

Breathe in the cultural heart of Catalan; an elegant blend of high energy and undisturbed tradition. Muse over the origins of captivating Gaudi architecture within the enchanting labyrinth that is the Gothic Quarter. Savour the flavours of fresh tapas and crisp cava in breezy plazas, tranquil terraces and coveted cafés, or glide down to a shimmering beach club to unwind. Imagine a visit to peaceful Passeig de Gracia, where modernist buildings merge to showcase iconic global labels. And, as dusk falls, prepare for urban action and swing by the lively bohemian bars to fiesta on the leafy stretch of La Rambla. If you're serious about style, this colourful city provides plenty to celebrate.

Day 2 - Palma de Mallorca, Spain

Tue 29 Dec 2026 | 8:00 A.M. - 7:00 P.M.

Leave craggy coastlines behind and venture to the heartland of the biggest Balearic. Where endless authentic charm, history and nature await. Celebrate at Spain's oldest winery, shop chic Palma boutiques and marvel at blossoming UNESCO-limestone mountains aboard a vintage train. Experience a tranquil monastery, art at a historic hacienda and tons of protected wildlife. Delve into nature at reserves, feast on wood-fired paella at lively hangouts, pilgrimage to historic churches and tour old-world Mallorcan villages. And as for sapphire seas that frame spotless beaches - Mallorca is truly an immense Balearic beauty.

Day 3 - Palamós (Girona), Spain

Wed 30 Dec 2026 | 9:00 A.M. - 7:00 P.M.

Endowed with an abundance of culinary and artistic riches, Girona is Catalonia unedited. Rising from Palamós to the medieval villages of Empordà and the foothills of the Pyrenees, the province reveals itself during languorous lunches in shaded squares and tastings in hilltop vineyards. Weave between epicurean experiences and colourful riverside houses in Girona, delve into the world and works of Salvador Dalí in Figueres and explore the dramatic cliffs, secluded calas and crystal-clear waters of the lesser-travelled Costa Brava.

Day 4-5 - At Sea - Fireworks, France // Overnight

Thu 31 Dec 2026 | Arrival 6:00 P.M. | Fri 1 Jan, Departure 2:00 A.M.

Anchored off the glittering shores of Cannes, dusk melts into a velvet sky as the Riviera begins to shimmer with anticipation. Gentle waves lap against the hull while laughter and music drift across the water, and glasses of champagne catch the last golden light. As night deepens, the bay awakens in brilliance—fireworks unfurl in radiant bursts above the Croisette, their reflections dancing across the sea. In this moment of light, elegance and celebration, Cannes reveals its most dazzling self.



Day 5 - Villefranche-sur-Mer (Nice), France

Fri 1 Jan 2027 | 9:00 A.M. - 8:00 P.M.

A bejewelled siren sunning along the Côte d'Azur, Villefranche-sur-Mer beckons with provincial scenes, rainbow-bright houses and flowers fluttering everywhere. Poised at the tip of a sapphire harbour, this genteel enclave has curves in all the right places, including the only Corniche that winds beside Plage des Marinière with its crescent flour-soft sand that sweeps around the cobalt Med. Escape into charming chapels and centuries-old citadel that affords shimmering views of Cap Ferrat then venture to two nearby medieval walled towns of atelier-focused St Paul de Vence or easy-on-the-eyes Eze which captured the imagination of Mr. Walt Disney.

Day 6 - Genoa, Italy

Sat 2 Jan 2027 | 9:00 A.M. - 7:00 P.M.

Pillow-soft sponge cakes, nutty pesto and barrels of creamy gelato await in historic Genoa, where young Christopher Columbus first glimpsed the sea. Wander cobbled streets past Baroque palazzi in the UNESCO-listed old town, where coffee-scented breezes drift through a labyrinth of alleyways near dazzling Piazza De Ferrari and its unmatched architecture. Dive into history among a treasure trove of galleries and museums in resplendent residences built for the bankers and merchants who made Genoa one of the mightiest ports in the Med. Surrender to the sunset serenade and heed the call of aperitivo as you stroll along Corso Italia beneath a fiery orange sky.

Day 7 - Livorno (Florence), Italy

Sun 3 Jan 2027 | 8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.

Plunge into Tuscany's capital of culture. Once casa to legendary Michelangelo, Florence now shelters some of the Renaissance's greatest masterpieces. Immerse in the relics of antiquity; catch a glimpse of the heavens in the famous Uffizi gallery, visit the iconic terracotta-tiled Duomo and step into an oasis of sculptured serenity at Giardino di Boboli to forget the world beyond its leafy walls exists. And as the sun sets over the Ponte Vecchio, relax in an elegant terrazzo with a rich refined Tuscan red, and reflect on the city's Medici dynasty - Hurry Slowly.

Day 8 - Civitavecchia (Rome), Italy

Mon 4 Jan 2027 | Arrival 8:00 A.M. | Disembarkation 9:15 A.M. - 10:30 A.M.

There's more to Rome than its ancient architecture. The Eternal City is home to a seemingly endless array of hidden gems. The artistic-minded can enjoy fashion aristocracy, street art, vespa jaunts to The Appian Way and toss coins into fountains. Or you can stroll by appointment to Michelangelo's Sistine Chapel and the Pope's private quarters at the Vatican. Explore the historic ruins of The Colosseum, Caravaggio churches, the Spanish Steps and The Pantheon. Learn how to make pasta the true Italian way, hunt truffles, nibble gelato, sip coffee and sink into a 3000 year old pool for a wellness experience. An ode to homespun pasta at a Renaissance piazza. When in Rome, fusing old with new makes it simple to indulge in whatever you like.
