Day 1 - Copenhagen, Denmark

Mon 10 May 2027 | Embarkation 12:00 P.M. - 3:00 P.M. | Departure 6:00 P.M.

Rejoice in one of the happiest and most vibrant capital cities in the world. Relax like a local alongside joyful Danes and varied culture; the Gefion Fountain, the Little Mermaid statue, Old Citadel, the Amalien Palace with four Rococo buildings, medieval history, charming fishing villages, leading examples of sustainable living and - of course - flaky Danish pastries. Cycling is the preferred way to shuttle across town and it's well worth the pedal to enjoy the trendy, cosy neighbourhood of Norrebro, Christiansborg Palace and the waterfront home of Christian Andersen. Genuine, vibrant and welcoming... rather like the smiles of those that live here.

Day 2 - At Sea

Tue 11 May 2027

With more time to reflect, rejuvenate, and embrace the Ocean State of Mind, days at sea with Explora Journeys invite moments of unhurried exploration. Day 3 - Helsinki, Finland

Wed 12 May 2027 | 8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.

Helsinki fuses urban design with a nourishing dose of nature. Nordic architecture merges with an archipelago of over 300 islands, an eco-friendly farm and a National Park. Get your Scandi style fix in Design District and feast on the neoclassical architecture of Senate Square, crowned by the frosted peaks of Helsinki Cathedral. Sustainability is central to Helsinki, where wellbeing thrives with inviting beaches, coastal kayaking and lake-side hiking. Roam to neighbouring Haikko, cook on a private island, fly by helicopter, feed reindeer and seek wellbeing in verdant Finnish forests.

Day 4-5 - Stockholm, Sweden // Overnight

Thu 13 May 2027 | Arrival 9:00 A.M. // Fri 14 May 2027 | Departure 4:00 P.M.

Spanning 14 islands linked by more than 50 bridges, Sweden's capital is often called the Venice of the North. A city where waterways and heritage blend effortlessly, Stockholm invites exploration on foot or by bicycle. Discover the cobbled charm of Gamla Stan, home to the narrow Mårten Trotzigs Gränd and the stately City Hall. Step inside the remarkable Vasa Museum to see the 17th-century warship that lay beneath the sea for over 300 years, or visit Skansen — the world's first open-air museum — for a glimpse into Swedish traditions. Across the water at Drottningholm Palace, the royal residence, the 18th-century Court Theatre still preserves its original stage machinery. Finally, stroll along the elegant Strandvägen waterfront, lined with grand townhouses and yachts gently swaying in the harbour.



Day 6 - Tallinn, Estonia

Sat 15 May 2027 | 9:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.

Romantic and revered, Tallinn boasts one of the best-preserved UNESCO old towns bursting with medieval magic. Hundreds of years of conquests and cross-culture history all fuel its current burgeoning status as one of Europe's most desirable jewels. Stroll cobbled alleys; squeeze through St. Catherine's Passage; scout the 13th century Toompea Castle. Hop two wheels to explore the national park and shore then have a Soviet flashback in the posh Kadriorg Palace (built for Catherine I) or below the black domes of Alexander Nevsky Cathedral.

Day 7 - Visby (Gotland), Sweden

Sun 16 May 2027 | 9:00 A.M. - 6:00 P.M.

Visit Visby on the island of Gotland for authentic Swedish riches. Well-preserved walls protect the city and set the scene for what lies within. You'll be warmly welcomed with cuisine, culture, nature and Viking archaeology. With a long history and UNESCO World Heritage ruins dating back to the 12th century, this orderly medieval town rejoices in being one of Scandinavia's best-preserved towns. Roam peaceful streets on foot or by bike to boutiques selling warm woollens for winter and shelves laden with local crafts. Visit the lengthy Lummelunda Cave in a nature reserve, experience the traditional Swedish coffee ritual and taste beer at the local brewery. Soak up the history and atmosphere in well-groomed Visby for a slice of time gone by.

Day 8 - Rønne, Denmark

Mon 17 May 2027 | 9:00 A.M. - 8:00 P.M.

The beautiful harbour town of Rønne is housed on the rocky island of Bornholm, home to narrow streets lined with merchant timber houses and small craft shops proudly displaying creative passion. Gently stroll to the heart of the art scene at Hjorths Fabrik museum and join workshops to create your own ceramic artefacts. In contrast to the bustling harbour, discover the fascinating street food market and cruise across waters in a private yacht. Charming and romantic, use a bike and roll around this pretty town at your own pace.

Day 9 - Copenhagen, Denmark

Tue 18 May 2027 | Arrival 8:00 A.M. | Disembarkation 9:15 A.M. - 10:30 A.M.
